Foundry Air Contaminants Training Seminar

During the manufacturing process, foundries and die-casters can release potentially hazardous contaminants into the workplace. These types of contaminants potentially emitted are dependent on the materials and process used to make castings. It is important for the management of these facilities to protect their employees from the hazards presented by these contaminants, not only to provide a safe work environment, but to also avoid potentially severe fines and criminal penalties from federal regulatory agencies.

The Non-Ferrous Founders' Society (NFFS), in conjunction with the Occupational Safety & Health Administration (OSHA), has developed a comprehensive course designed specifically for foundry industry professionals.
